
## The Savior is My Shepherd



For performance by children, I recommend cutting out some of the lower, more powerful notes, in the base clef. Doing this, makes the hymn somewhat "lighter".







The chorus begins in Measure 16 with the words, "The Savior is my Shepherd." It continues to the last two measures which are, "I'll live with Him again" and is sung with a repeat of the last two measures ONLY on the second verse. These last two measures are to be performed with moderate or full volume (the first time) and then as SLOWLY, QUIETLY and REVERENTLY as possible the second time.

The line above it (which starts at measure 18) and is, "who loves and cares for me" is performed with power and strength.

This hymn may be performed by younger children because it speaks of the Savior as a shepherd and children easily relate to this image. The hymn is also recommended for young adults and adults.
